City of Hafnarfjördur

Hafnarfjördur is a vibrant, picturesque town in southwest Iceland, providing visitors a nearby alternative to the capital city. Just a ten-minute drive from the bright lights of Reykjavík, guests to Hafnarfjördur can take in the best of both communities.

Set amid a lava field, the town is surrounded by a lunar-like landscape, rumoured to be inhabited by elves and other mysterious beings. A ride on horseback through the eerie volcanic landscape is an unforgettable experience.

Hafnarfjördur is fillend with quaint old houses and contains a bustling harbour, galleries, theatres, a schopping mall, and a Viking village where visitors can meet Thor, the Norse god of thunder. Other attractions include a lava golf cource, one of the best in Europe, pleasant walking trails, a highly active geothermal area and specatcular ciliffs teeming with bird life. Iceland's famous Blue Lagoon in only 20 minutes away.



Hafnarfjördur is also the start of The Golden Circle, a loop around south Iceland that includes stops at several of Iceland's most impressive natural phenomena. Hafnarfjördur is ideal for crew and passanger change, due to the short distance (38 km) to the International Airport, Keflavik.
