- 1.A team of Kenyan teachers to visit Hafnarfjörður and work in your schools to learn best practices. In exchange, Hafnarfjörður teachers would also visit Kenya and share experiences in Kenyan schools.
- 2. Schools in Hafnarfjörður to twin with schools in Kenya and develop long lasting partnerships at both institutional and individual levels.
- 3. Football clubs, Handball clubs and cultural groups from Kenya to participate in sports and cultural festivals in Hafnarfjörður, and vice-versa.
- 4.Link youth and women groups, sports and cultural groups in Kenya to youth, women and clubs in Hafnarfjörður.
- 5. Establish a Hafnarfjörður-Kenyans Friendship Group to promote these activities, including exploring investment opportunities both sides.
- 6.Hafnarfjörður to consider supporting a sports academy in Kenya to serve as a center for sports and cultural exchange.
- 7. Joint program to develop sports and arts talent in children and youth. Icelandic and Kenyan children/youth to visit and participate in events in both countries.
- 8. Hafnarfjörður to partner with Ababu Namwamba Foundation in supporting charitable initiatives.

Please do accept our appreciation for the guided tour of sports facilities in Hafnarfjörður, which you graciously arranged at such short notice. We picked up some very useful lessons.

Let me also take this opportunity to welcome you to Kenya. It would be great for you to grace the official opening in September of Veslo School, which has been built with Icelandic charity to educate children from poor families.
